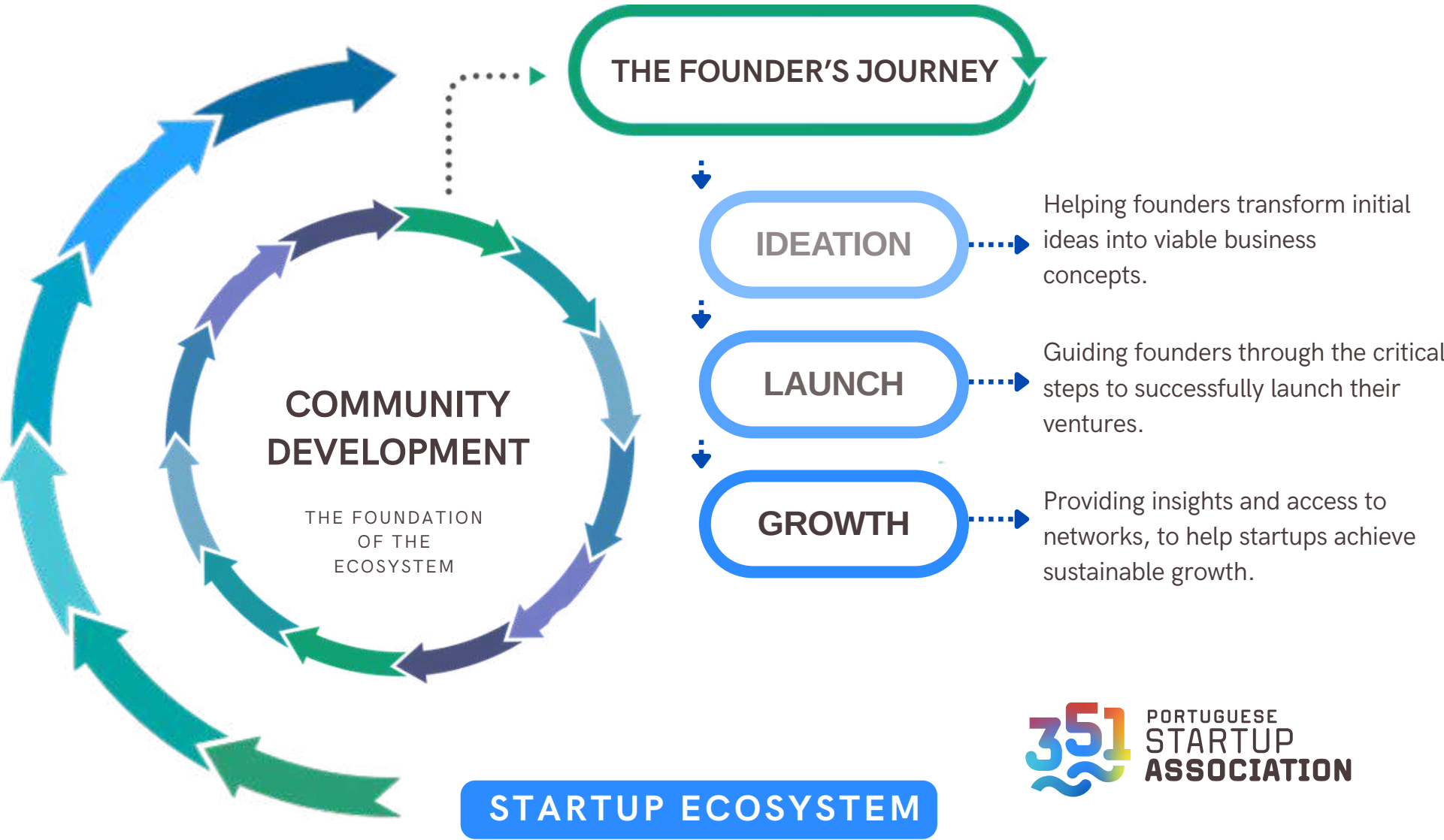

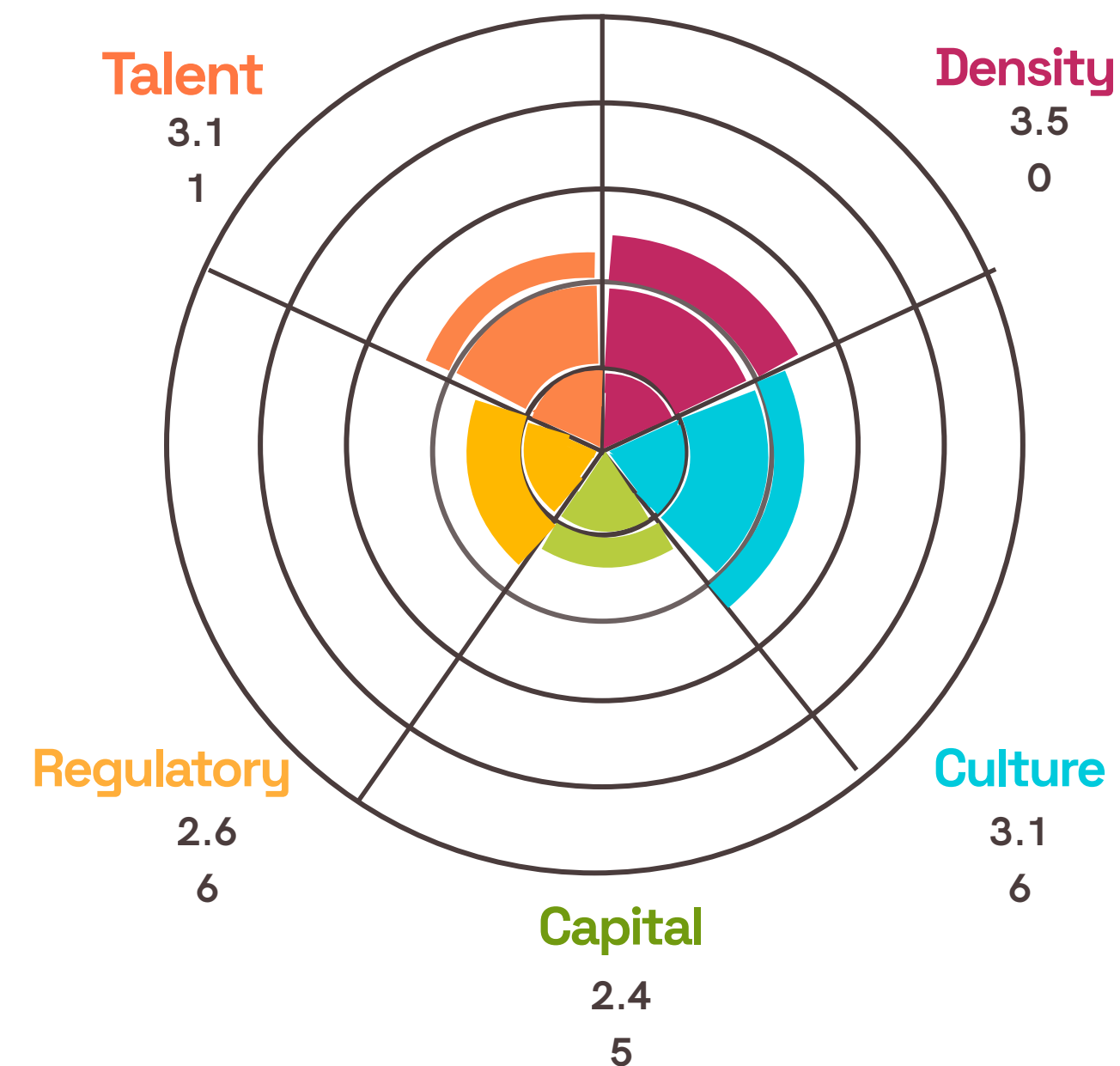
Techstars CLA - Community Leader Academy

Held on September 20-21, 2025, the CLA brought together 36 curated leaders from across Portugal — including Lisbon, Porto, Leiria, Aveiro, Coimbra, Algarve, and Madeira — to **analyse the national startup landscape and co-create solutions.**

Ahead of the event, the 351 team mapped the Portuguese startup ecosystem using the Techstars methodology, assessing five key pillars: **Talent, Density, Culture, Capital, and Regulatory Framework.**

Facilitated by Marta Baptista and Catarina Ferreira, the sessions brought together founders, investors, corporate partners, public sector representatives, and regional ecosystem builders - ensuring a diverse national perspective.

Ongoing working groups are translating the Academy's proposals into concrete, measurable actions.

The Nuvem Initiative

In 2025, 351 Startups joined the Nuvem Initiative to promote a more competitive and inclusive cloud market, tackling barriers such as vendor lock-in.

- Recognised as a key stakeholder, Nuvem will contribute to the upcoming Cloud Sovereignty Law.
- We also joined CDAP working groups, shaping discussions on cloud infrastructure, data governance, and public procurement.
- In collaboration with AMA, we are helping align the Cloud Framework Agreement with startup needs, improving access to public contracts and supporting digital sovereignty.

Global Voice & Local Support

International Policy & Networks

True impact happens beyond internal ecosystems.

At 351 Startups, we advocate for founders globally while fueling the grassroots initiatives that keep our ecosystem alive. In 2025, this meant acting as the logistical and promotional backbone for community-led events and representing the Portuguese voice at global summits.

Our commitment to external representation is solidified through our work with ESN on policy-making and our integration into world-class networks including Deep Ecosystems, the OECD, and the Founder Institute (FI). Whether we are shaping international policy or supporting local facilitators, we are dedicated to serving the broader entrepreneurial world.



Global Advocacy

OECD/YEPA

We work closely with national and international institutions, including the OECD, and have contributed to shaping Portuguese public policies related to entrepreneurship.

In recent years, 351 has supported the Portuguese Government through two major initiatives:

National Strategy for Incubators and Accelerators:

We were invited to join a government discussion group to share insights on what could be improved in the incubator and accelerator ecosystem in Portugal.

Boosting Green Entrepreneurship

We were part of a panel in public consultations with the government and joined a private working group with key stakeholders to help design policies that support startup growth and scale-up development.

In addition, the Association was invited by the OECD to contribute to a project focused on Boosting Youth Entrepreneurship. As part of this initiative, we shared best practices and were invited to run workshops for over 150 policymakers from across Europe, representing all 27 EU countries.

Finally, 351 was also invited by the OECD to take part in a project on Digital Civic Collaboration. In this context, we supported the OECD by sharing best practices and by bringing Portuguese startups to participate in a conference held in Portugal.

European Startup Network (ESN)

As a Member of ESN we have strengthened our ties with the broader European ecosystem and amplified the voice of Portuguese startups, allowing us to advocate more effectively for the interests of startups.

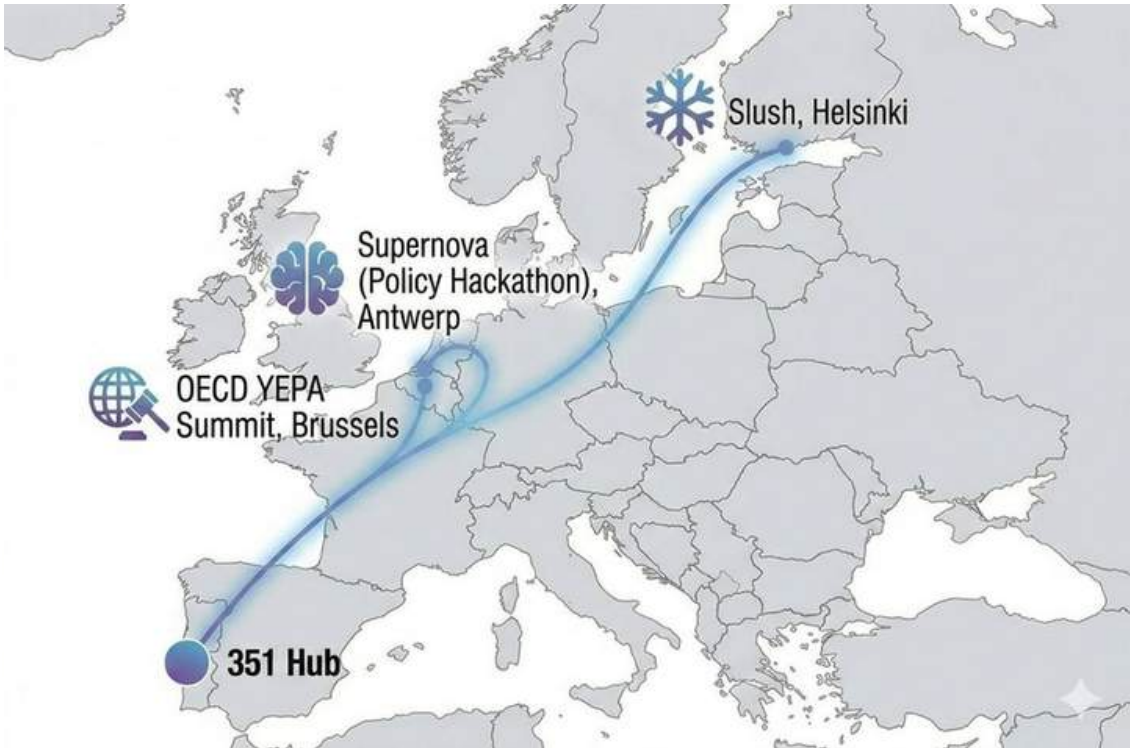
Selected initiatives and contributions:

- Drafting and contributing amendments to the European Startup and Scaleup Strategy.
- Elisa Tarzia, our VP, was a speaker at the ASCEND Innovation Conference in Copenhagen (25-26 November).

351 leverages its international alliances to ensure Portuguese founders have a seat at the table in global policy discussions. We advocate for the interests of our community at the highest levels through our active roles in the European Startup Network and the OECD.

Participation in International Events

We believe in the power of shared knowledge and collaboration. By engaging in international events, we both share our experience and bring back best practices to strengthen the Portuguese ecosystem.

In 2025, we delivered 4 Startup Weekends across 4 Portuguese cities.

The Techstars Startup Weekend is one of the world’s leading startup creation programmes. It is a three-day event that brings together entrepreneurs, developers, designers, and specialists from various fields to collaborate on startup creation projects. 351 a the official partner for Techstars programmes in Portugal.

STARTUPPERS

StartuppERS is a program designed to support entrepreneurs in launching and developing their startups.

The initiative provided workshops and masterclasses led by international experts on critical topics ranging from idea validation to investment. Participants gained access to specialized mentorship, strategic networking, and essential tech tools worth up to €700,000, in a program focused on practical growth and scalability.

Startup Clinics

Made by the 351 Portuguese Startup Association. Proudly supported by Terra Lucida.

Startup Clinics is an in-person event series focused on early-stage startup development.

A 5-session in-person series in Lisbon (May – June 2025) focused on the critical stages of startup idea development, running alongside the StartuppERS program.

Sessions were led by Inês Boski (Terra Lucida), a process innovation specialist with 8+ years of international experience in software product management and project leadership across European startup and corporate ecosystems.

Throughout 2025, we hosted a series of knowledge-sharing sessions focused on growth, marketing, and networking. These were delivered through a mix of formats: some were integrated into structured programs like the Founder Institute, others served as strategic pre-events for Startup Weekends, and several were held as standalone sessions to address specific community needs.

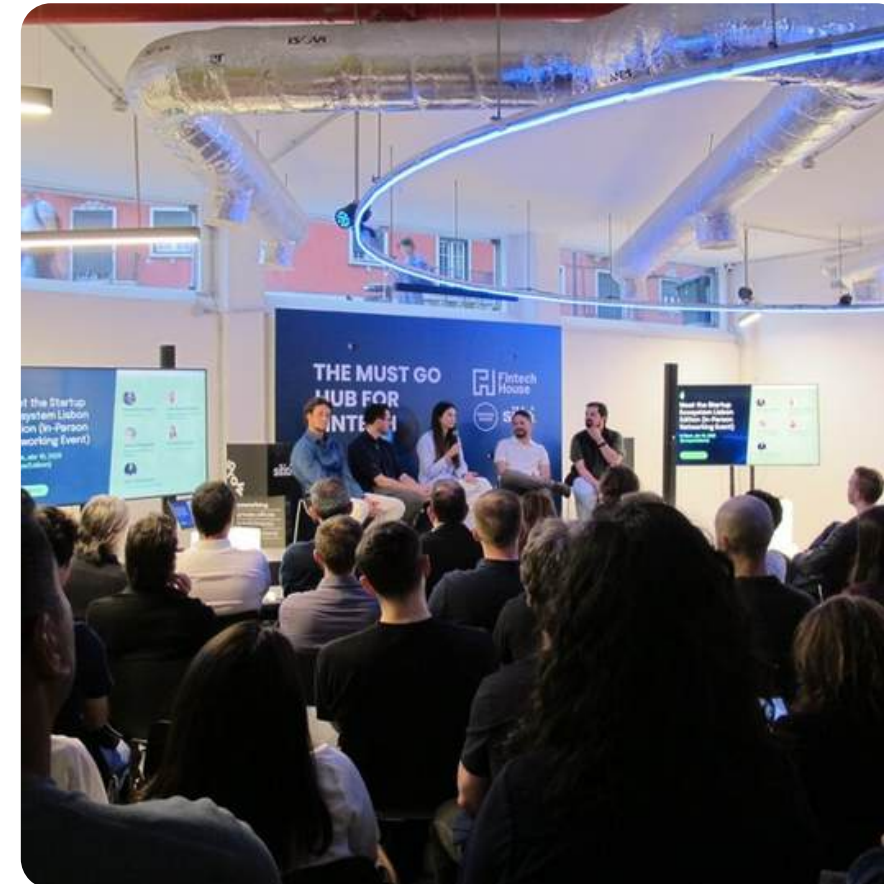

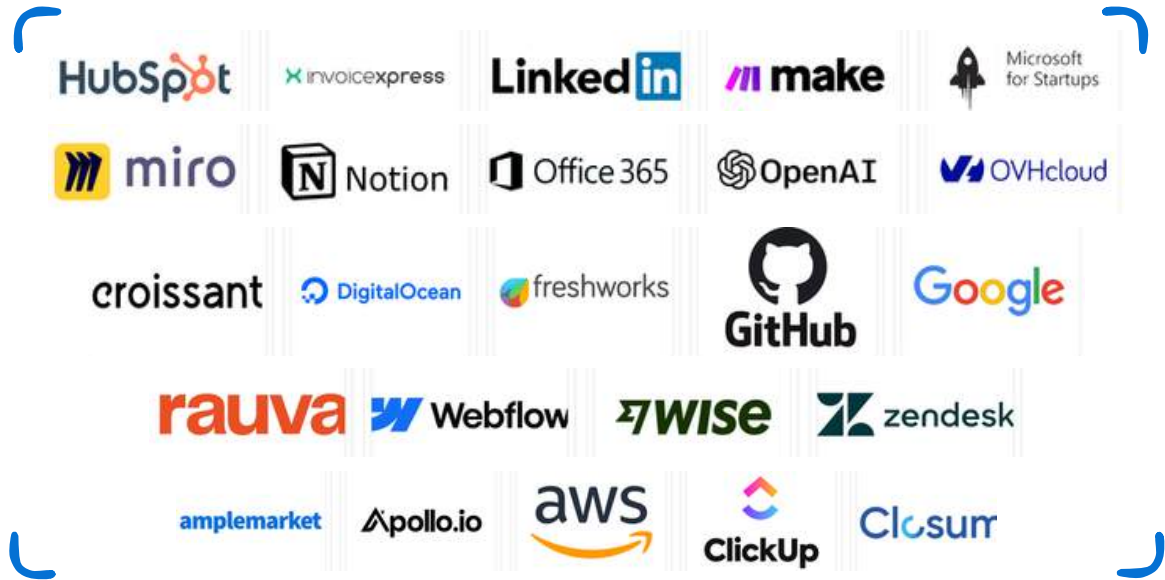

The iconic Elétrico Pitch (4th Edition) @Portugal Tech Week

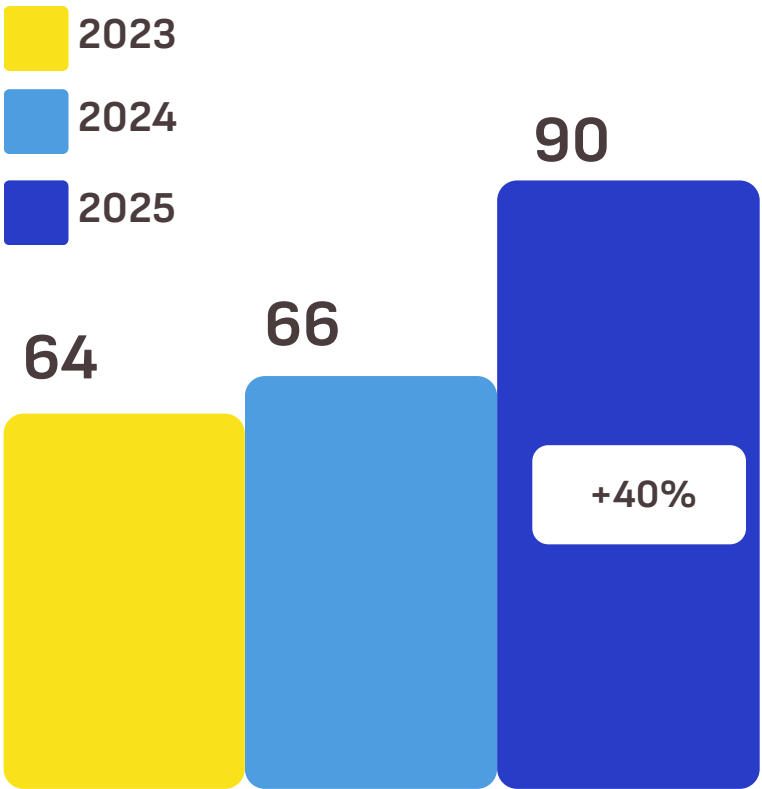

The story of 351 Startups is the collective narrative of everyone who joins us - whether as a volunteer, a founder, or a participant in our programs. We work every day to spark more of these life-changing moments, fostering a positive cycle of growth that expands and improves the lives of those around us. By empowering one individual, we strengthen the entire community, creating a chain of impact that makes our ecosystem better for everyone.



At just 13 years old, Francisco joined Startup Weekend Albufeira and proved that innovation has no age by building a startup in just 54 hours.

His father, Rui Barroca, noted the profound impact of the event: *"It is essential to have these 'small yet great' experiences that open doors to the world. For Francisco, it was the discovery of a new reality where he could engage with people from diverse fields and shape his identity as an entrepreneur."*

For Andrea, 351 served as a bridge out of isolation, helping him step "out of his shell" to socialize and find the essential events his business needed to grow.

After joining as a volunteer for Startupper, Tomás utilized the network to secure a position at Nova SBE.

Following her participation in Startupper, Elodie transformed a long, complex pitch into a winning presentation that secured victory at the Startup23 Demo day.

For years, our primary mission was to build this "village" - a startup ecosystem where founders and their ideas could grow, connect, and compete on a global stage. Having successfully built that foundation, 351 Startups is now embracing a new positioning: bringing a more structured way to support startup founders through every stage of their journey.



Building the Founder's Journey: Our 2026 Actions

In 2026, we are deploying specific programs and revamping our core offerings to ensure that our mission is a daily reality:

Startup Ideation & Validation:

- **Startupper Program:** Continuing our commitment to taking aspiring entrepreneurs from the very first spark of an idea to a validated concept.
- **Techstars Startup Weekends:** We are expanding our support to ensure more Techstars Startup Weekends happen across the country, both organized by us and by empowered local leaders.

Startup Structured Launch:

- **Founder Institute (FI) Portugal:** We are continuing our partnership with the world's largest pre-accelerator to provide the rigorous structure founders need before incorporation.

Startup Growth & Global Market Access:

- **Founders Weekend & Workshops:** Intensive programs and expert-led educational events focused on growth, marketing, branding, and execution.
- **International Network Expansion:** Leveraging 351's international delegations and global partners - such as ESN, Deep Ecosystems, OECD, Techstars, Startup Grind, and FI - to provide Portuguese startups with direct access to new markets.

Membership & Physical Hub

- **Revamped Memberships:** Following an extensive review throughout 2025, we are launching a redesigned membership to support individuals and startups looking to scale, providing access to expert mentors in business growth, as well as connections to international clients and global investors.
- **351 Physical Hub:** Our new physical home in 2026, a central meeting point to foster real-world connections and host an expanded calendar of community events.

Financing & Global Influence:

- **Funding Programme:** Initiatives like the Santander X Awards, Elétrico Pitch and the Community Fund will continue to connect startups to capital and international networks.
- **Policy-Making & Global Reach:** Leveraging our seat at the European Startup Network (ESN) and our ongoing work with the OECD/YEPA to advocate for the interests of founders at the highest levels of government.

Ecosystem & Community:

- **Portugal Tech Week Expansion:** Growing the largest innovation festival in Portugal to reach more people, nationally and internationally.
- **Ecosystem Facilitation:** We will never stop supporting community development, ensuring that local leaders have the tools they need to foster innovation in their own cities.
